What is the Hour of Code?

The Hour of Code is a global movement reaching tens of millions of students in 180+ countries. It started as a one-hour introduction to computer science, designed to demystify “code”, to show that anybody can learn the basics, and to broaden participation in the field of computer science. It has since become a worldwide effort to celebrate computer science, starting with 1-hour coding activities but expanding to all sorts of community efforts. This grassroots campaign is already supported by over 200,000 educators worldwide.

By starting early, students will have a foundation for success in any 21st-century career path. Heart Plus Smart

The Hour of Code is provided by Finastra free of charge through our Heart Plus Smart corporate social responsibility (CSR) program. You will have a local CSR contact within Finastra who will oversee the entire program with your school or club once your participation has been approved.

Creating a Timetable

Your local CSR contact will work with you to establish a timetable to deliver an Hour of Code to all eligible children. Finastra aims to deliver at least one Hour of Code to all children you feel would benefit from the program however, we prioritize children between 7 - 11 years old and have dedicated programs for disadvantaged children.

Format of the Session

For Hour of Code sessions at a Finastra site, children will be provided with a tour of our office before starting the class with the instructor. The experience usually lasts between 1.5 - 2 hours and Finastra always likes to provide snacks, treats and drinks to children if they are allowed!
