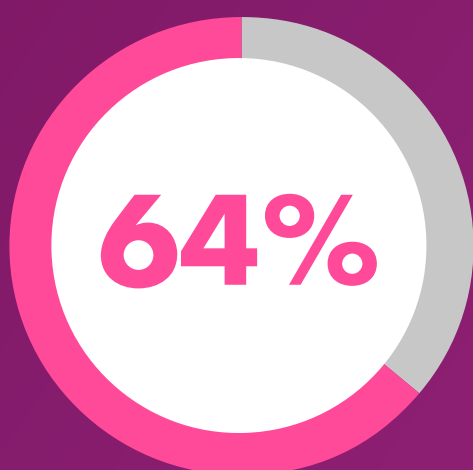

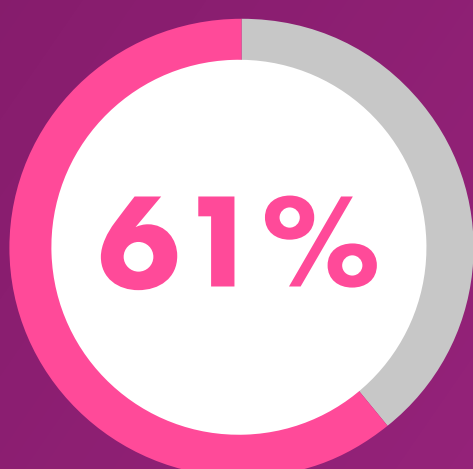

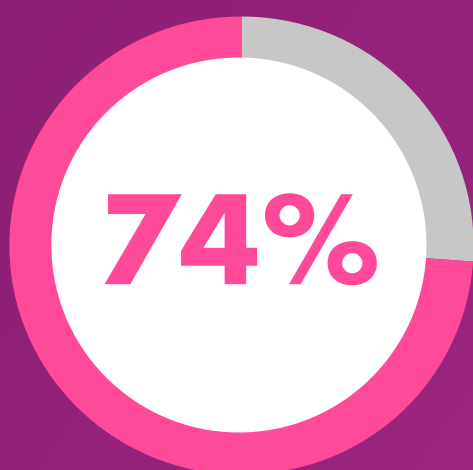
Here's what they're after:
