In 2023 alone, noncompliance fines exceeded US\$10 billion. Compliance has become a strategic priority, not just a regulatory requirement. Treasury systems must adopt real-time monitoring solutions that detect risks and prevent violations.

The Opics Compliance Monitoring Tool empowers middle-office risk teams with an intuitive platform for defining and monitoring compliance rules across trade instruments.

Integrated with Opics, the tool enhances the overall risk management framework within treasury operations. The unified setup allows consistent data flow between the compliance and treasury functions, which facilitates streamlined limits monitoring and compliance.

Risk teams can define and enforce rules within the same platform used for treasury activities, ensuring real-time visibility, efficient breach handling, and instant alerts on rule violations.

The tool enables banks to:

- Set custom limits for pre and post-deal checks
- · Continuously scan transactions, risk limits, and exposure thresholds, flagging potential breaches before they escalate
- · Monitor and receive real-time alerts with a unified dashboard, along with end-of-day reports easily shared via email

Custom rule definition:

The compliance tool offers a flexible framework for defining custom rules based on specific business needs, ensuring alignment with organizational risk policies and regulatory requirements

Users can define rules across:

- Asset classes Targeted monitoring based on unique risk profiles of the asset type
- Trade data Configure rules for specific data fields for precise control over compliance parameters
- User-defined Combine data fields across multiple arrays
- Workflows Customize workflows to meet special compliance requirements



Trade Execution in Opics:

Traders initiate and confirm Money Market trades within Opics Treasury. Once the trade details are finalized, the execution is processed through the system, capturing all necessary information for compliance verification.



Automatic trade transmission:

Upon execution, trade information is automatically sent to the Compliance Monitoring Tool. Trades are promptly available for compliance assessment without manual intervention, thereby reducing the risk of errors.



Pre- deal limits

Front office trading system (Opics) users can run compliance tests before trade execution for rules defined in the compliance monitoring platform. This function evaluates trades against predefined limits to minimize financial losses, reduce non-compliance risks and penalties, streamline operations, enhance accountability with a clear audit trail, and empower traders to make informed decisions



Post-deal limits

Monitor executed trades in Opics to ensure adherence to limits, identify violations, and assess the impact on trading exposure and overall regulatory needs. The feature facilitates corrective measures for identified breaches and continuously refines risk management strategies and compliance protocols.



Breach manager

Enable centralized tracking of compliance breaches with timely alerts to stakeholders, promoting regulatory adherence and proactive risk management.



Dashboards

Take a comprehensive view of monitoring and compliance risks in the system. Users can view risks associated with trades based on breaches raised by custom rules. This enables treasurers and risk officers to act on cases and make informed decisions in near real-time, ensuring smooth operations and regulatory adherence.



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
